BJUP Bible Truths – A Servant’s Heart includes Bible references for independent Bible study, hymns, Bible area maps, and a glossary of Bible terms. The enjoyable activities on colorful pages reinforce Bible accounts and encourage students to apply Bible knowledge to their everyday lives. Units of study are:

BJUP Math 2 is a manipulative-based concept approach to mathematics understanding. Emphasis is placed on skill practice, a spiraling review, how to use manipulatives for concrete understanding, and fact memorization supported by songs and games. Parent involvement is essential. BJUP English 2 places importance on traditional grammar as well as practice with reference skills and step-by-step use of the Writing Process for eight different types of writing assignments. The Writing Handbook contains thesaurus and writing models, and the Grammar Handbook contains lists of grammar models. Practice in the worktext include:

- Supplemental Reading


BJUP Spelling 2 presents words arranged in same-sound, different-spelling groups for auditory memory. Enjoyable activities enable the student to practice writing the weekly spelling list. Also included are dictionary skills and a spelling dictionary. Bonus words are added that coordinate with other subjects.

BJUP Handwriting 2 is used as the transition into cursive writing. The worktext uses cursive models of scripture, poetry, recipes, and thank-you notes. The following correct writing practices are stressed:

- Good posture
- Correct paper position
- Holding pencil correctly
- Proper letter formation
- Even spacing
- Neatness

Hands-on Science 2 presents God's earth and His creation clearly as students study these topics:

- The Body (Skin, Skeleton, Muscles)
