Worktext practice activities include time lines, diaries, logs, and maps. Skill development and review of cursive letters is encouraged through guided practice with the teacher.

BJUP Reading 3 guides the student to build reading comprehension, grow in phonics skill, and at the same time take in character-building stories that demonstrate biblical truth and timeless virtues. Godly character is saturated into these types of literature:


